Project External Quality Evaluator

The eQteL Consortium has approved, during the mid-term project meeting in 12-13 May 2015, that “Professor Abdallah Al-Zoubi presented EACEA’s approval for Professor Mike Blakemore to act as an external evaluator of the project”. The project time-span is from March 1, 2015 and 30 November 2016.

Role: To support and advise the Project Director in ongoing quality issues relating to the overall operation and progress of the project, (noting also that specific academic quality assurance issues are being addressed by the consortium partners as part of the project scope).

Specific Activities

- To support and advise the Project Director on an ongoing basis regarding issues relating to the progress of the project.
- To provide two formal quality reports to the Project Director and the Consortium around key consortium meeting dates– proposed months would be November/December 2015 and September/October 2016. The reports will focus on:
 1. Relevance – progress towards achieving the objectives
 2. Efficiency – project direction and management
 3. Effectiveness – the roles and function of the consortium
 4. Impact – dissemination, communication, and progress towards impact goals
 5. Sustainability – planning for viability beyond the period of funding.
- To provide informal reports to the Project Director and the Consortium where the evaluator attends key project meetings. The reports will be structured along the lines of ‘observations’ and ‘recommendations’.
- To make three visits to Jordan to review progress. Possible dates (to be discussed and confirmed) are December 12-15/16 2015; then (depending on the work plan) April and September 2016. The visits will normally involve travel to Amman on a Saturday, work with the project on Sunday to Tuesday, and returning to the UK on Wednesday. The fee of 5500 euros will be paid in two stages of 2750 euros, on the acceptance of the two formal quality reports.
